On Thursday, September 17, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., the Regional Planning Affiliation 8 (RPA 8) will hold a Public Hearing for approval of Amendment to Federal Fiscal Year 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program, Amendment to RPA 8 Fiscal Year 2016-2020 Passenger Transportation Plan (PTP), Draft Fiscal Year 2019 RPA 8 Title VI Non-Discrimination Program Plan and Draft Fiscal Year 2019 RPA 8 Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan.

The public is invited to submit their input. The Public Hearing will be held at East Central Intergovernmental Association, Community room, 7600 Commerce Park, Dubuque, Iowa. This facility is accessible under the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act. RPA 8 receives federal funding and may not discriminate against anyone on the basis of race, color, or national origin, according to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. The TIP is prepared and adopted each year and contains projects for the coming four fiscal years. The PTP is designed to provide needs-based project justification for all transit programs within the Dubuque Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (DMATS) and Regional Planning Affiliation 8 (RPA 8). The Title VI Non-Discrimination Program Plan is designed to address title VI regulations within RPA 8 area and Limited English Proficiency plan is designed to address how RPA 8 will accommodate non-English-speaking population in planning and decision-making process.

The Amended FFY 2018-2021 TIP, Amended Fiscal Year 2016-2020 PTP, Draft FY 2019 RPA 8 Title VI Non-Discrimination Program Plan and Draft Fiscal Year 2019 RPA 8 LEP Plan are currently available for review at the office of the Dubuque Metropolitan Area Transportation Study, ECIA, 7600 Commerce Park, Dubuque, Iowa.
