Regional Planning Affiliation 8 (RPA 8) conducts transportation planning for Clinton, Delaware, Dubuque and Jackson Counties.

The RPA 8 Long Range Transportation Plan maps out how the region's communities will invest \$ 156 million in transportation funding between now and 2040.

RPA 8 updates the Long Range Transportation Plan every 5 years.

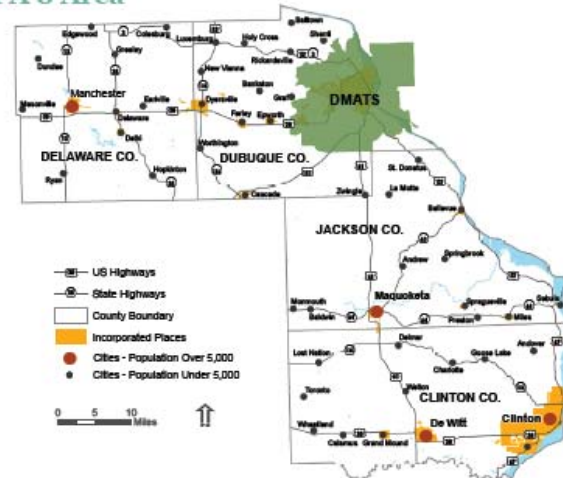
