What is the Long Range Transportation Plan?

The Dubuque Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (DMATS) is currently updating its 2055 Long Range Transportation Plan. This plan maps out a long-range vision for managing and improving the region's transportation system over the next 30 years. The DMATS area includes the city of Dubuque and surrounding cities and rural areas in Iowa, Illinois, and Wisconsin (see map).
