The RPA Technical Advisory Board meeting was called to order by RPA Technical Advisory Board Chair, Todd Kinney at 10:31 a.m.

Review/Approve the Agenda for the Thursday, August 28, 2025 Technical Advisory Board and Policy Board joint meeting

Review/Approve resolution supporting RTA's request for Federal Transit Authority's Rural Transit Assistance Program funds

Ravada explained that the RTA is seeking funding and will submit an application for the Community Rides Grant Program. This funding aims to develop a comprehensive marketing program to address the lack of awareness surrounding RTA services, combat misconceptions that these services are only for specific riders and address the shortage of drivers. The resolution states that RPA 8 will be a key partner for the RTA in enhancing awareness of its services by providing data, assisting with survey methods, conducting data collection, and facilitating the implementation of the Community Rides Grant project.

Motion by Vick, second by Lindner to recommend approval to the RPA 8 Policy Board the resolution supporting RTA's request for Federal Transit Authority's Rural Transit Assistance Program funds. The motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Flagel, second by Madlom to approve the resolution supporting RTA's request for Federal Transit Authority's Rural Transit Assistance Program funds. The motion passed unanimously.

Review/Approve the ranking criteria for the RPA 8 Transportation Alternative funding program

Fox went over the ranking criteria for the RPA TAP funds. Fox stated due to past discussions staff added points for network expansion. The project needs to show that it expands the regional network by adding a new facility, or does it replace or reconstruct an existing facility.

Discussion followed.

Fox stated the network expansion criteria description will be added to the regional impact criteria, but the points for regional impact will stay the same.

Ravada stated there are 5 applications received for TAP funds. Ravada stated that a subcommittee needs to be formed to rank the TAP applications. The subcommittee is made up of engineers and city representatives.

Ravada confirmed the board members that volunteered to be on the subcommittee. The five board members who volunteered were Weber, Koopman, Vick, Madlom, and Mickel.

Motion by Weber, second by Scheckel to recommend to the RPA 8 Policy Board the subcommittee for ranking RPA 8 Transportation Alternative Funding Applications. The motion passed unanimously.

Review/Approve Small City representatives for RPA 8

Ravada stated the small city representatives were nominated by the mayors of each county and they are as follows: Clinton County, Andrew Kida; Jackson County, Kelley Brown; Delaware County, Linda Gaul. Ravada stated the Dubuque County mayors have not appointed a new small city representative but plan to appoint someone at the next mayors meeting.
