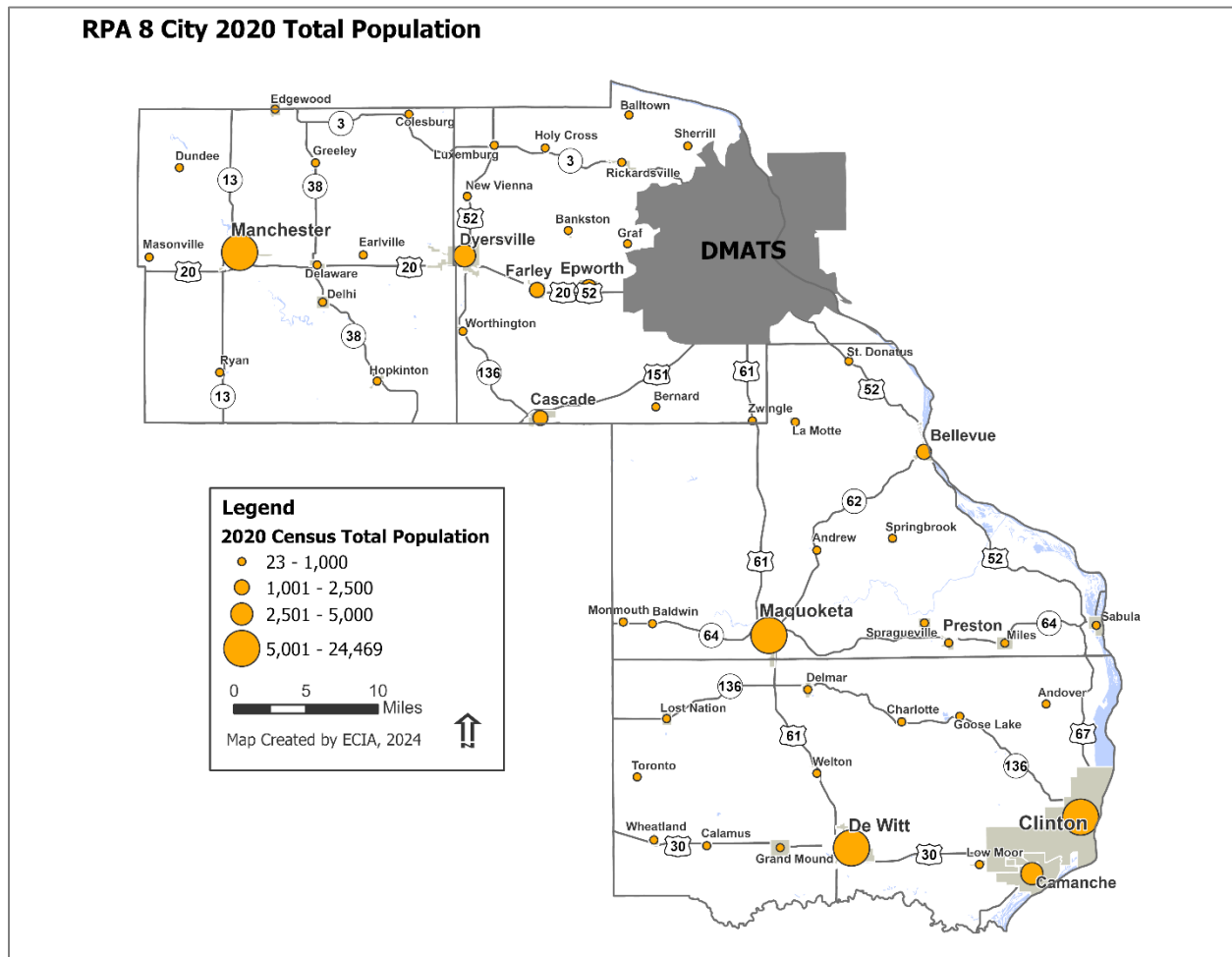


Regional Planning Affiliation 8 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan Survey
