DMATS RESOLUTION 2025-11-1

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE EAST CENTRAL IOWA TRANSPORATION SAFETY PLAN FUNDED BY THE SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT

- WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) launched the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program to support local, regional, and tribal initiatives to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries; and
- WHEREAS, DMATS, in partnership with Regional Planning Affiliation 8 (RPA 8) and the Institute for Transportation at Iowa State University (InTrans), was awarded funding through the SS4A grant program in 2023 to develop a comprehensive safety action plan for 58 cities within the Dubuque Iowa-Illinois Metropolitan Area and Clinton, Delaware, Dubuque, and Jackson counties; and
- WHEREAS, DMATS, in coordination with planning and engineering professionals, local stakeholders, and members of the public, has completed the development of a data-driven comprehensive safety action plan entitled the East Central Iowa Transportation Safety Plan; and
- **WHEREAS,** the plan outlines specific strategies, projects, and policy recommendations to improve roadway safety for all users, including pedestrians, cyclists, motorists, and transit riders; and
- **WHEREAS**, adoption of plan demonstrates the region's commitment to improving public safety and supports eligibility for future implementation funding through the SS4A program and other funding sources; and
- **WHEREAS**, the plan establishes the goal of reducing roadway fatalities and serios injuries by fifty percent by the year 2050, and the eventual elimination of all roadway fatalities and serious injuries; and
- **WHEREAS**, the DMATS Policy Committee finds that adoption of the *East Central Iowa Transportation Safety Plan* is in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

that the DMATS Policy Committee hereby adopts the *East Central Iowa Transportation Safety Plan* and authorizes DMATS staff to submit the adopted plan to the U.S. Department of Transportation in fulfillment of the SS4A grant requirements.
