The following applications were recommended for funding by the subcommittee, The City of Clinton for \$500,000; the City of Camanche for \$500,000, and the City of Maquoketa for \$142,502.

Also, to evaluate alternatives for Honey Creek Road, specifically from the E Honey Creek Drive intersection to the Highway 13 intersection in the City of Manchester. Ravada stated RPA expects to complete the selection process by the first week of November 2025 and the anticipated start date for the contract is January 5, 2025.
