## **Review/Approve amendments to Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2024-2027 RPA 8 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**

Ravada referred to the TIP, stating amendments to the TIP are:

- Dubuque County, bridge replacement project, on Bennettville Rd over Buncombe Creek
- Jackson County, bridge replacement project, on 82<sup>nd</sup> Ave over Maquoketa River
- Jackson County, bridge replacement project, on 74<sup>th</sup> Street over S Fork Maquoketa River
- City of Maquoketa, pcc pavement and replacement project, on E Maple Road

- City of Clinton, grade and pave, on trail on 13<sup>th</sup> Street from Pershing Blvd 1.7 miles to N 14<sup>th</sup> Street, then south 930LF on N 14<sup>th</sup> Street
- City of DeWitt, grade and pave, along 11<sup>th</sup> Street from Westbrook Pk to Westbrook Dr, north to 12<sup>th</sup> Street Ct
- Transit amendments included additional funding RTA and Clinton MTA received for new buses

Ravada clarified what TAP funds are used for; these funds are used for trail and trail systems. Members can apply for up to \$250,000.00 in funds.

**Update on the Rural County Transportation Program (RCTP)**

Ravada congratulated the board as the board received a national award for the RCTP program from the National Association Development Officials (NADO). Ravada stated the RCTP program has helped fund eight-two projects over the last 6 years.
