## **Call to Order**

The RPA Technical Advisory Board meeting was called to order by RPA Technical Advisory Board Chair, Todd Kinney at 10:01 a.m.

The RPA Policy Board meeting was called to order by RPA Policy Board Chair, Scott Maddasion at 10:01 a.m. Introductions were made at this time.

## **Review/Approve the revised Agenda for the Thursday, January 22, 2026 Technical Advisory Board and Policy Board joint meeting**

**Approve/Receive Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG) project applications for Federal Fiscal Year 2027-2030 from RPA 8 members**

Ravada referred to the handout showing the projects of each member. Ravada stated the balances by the end of FY 2030 are as followed:

- City of Clinton-\$993,366.00
- City of Dewitt-\$566,867.00
- Delaware County-\$748,366.00
- City of Manchester-\$40,041.00
- Dubuque County-\$1,685,212.00
- Jackson County-\$753,056.00
- City of Maquoketa-\$515,633.00
- Small Cities-\$254,296.00

Ravada suggested the Board members to review their budget to see if they have any projects they would like included for STBG projects for FFY 2027-2030.

**Review/Approve the release of Small City Surface Transportation Block Grant Program applications**

Ravada stated, currently RPA 8 has a balance of \$254,296.00 in STBG funds in the small city account. Ravada stated the Board can release the applications for small cities to utilize the current funding or wait another year and let the funds grow.

Ravada stated within the budget there is \$415,840 for the Transportation Alternative SET – ASIDE Program. Ravada requested the board to open the application process so staff can start receiving applications for this program. Ravada stated the cap for this program is \$250,000.

Fox reviewed the TAP application form and guidelines. Fox stated the application process can be opened now or in the spring.

**Discussion on the SS4A Safety Projects for grant applications**
