## **Review/Approve Bike and Pedestrian Plan for Dubuque County**

Fox presented the bike and pedestrian plan to the board. Fox stated the purpose is to develop a plan to expand and improve the bicycle and pedestrian network as part of the regional transportation system. During this update staff reviewed related plans and federal policies, reviewed existing conditions, facilities, common challenges, lack of safety options and crash potentials at sites. Staff also gathered stakeholder and community feedback through a survey, developed a future network plan and implemented the plan. Fox went over some guidance for communities to move forward. Fox also introduced an interactive project map that the community and view to see existing and future bike and ped facilities.

## **Review Planning process for Safe Roads and Streets for All (SS4A) for cities within RPA 8 region**

Fox went over staff's planning process for SS4A. Fox stated that there are 58 cities staff will be contacting and working with to discuss their safety needs and concerns. Fox stated meetings will be held online and in-person. Staff would also like to form a county steering committee in all four counties to meet throughout the process and serve as the plan steering committee. Staff also plan on holding public input meetings and providing an online survey for the public. The goal is to complete the plan by spring 2025 and submit implementation grant applications in July 2025.
