Review/Approve amendments to Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2023-2026 RPA 8 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Ravada referred to the TIP handout stating the amendments to the TIP are:

- Dubuque County, Fishpond Road Bridge replacement
- Clinton County, 235th Street Overflow Bridge
- City of Manchester, East Main Street, from Stiles St to Bailey Dr
- Clinton County, Old Hwy 61 Overflow bridge
- City of Clinton, Second Ave Rd over Little Mill Creek
- RTA, funding to replace 3 light duty buses, cost went from \$90k to \$170k

Motion by Kenniker, second by Kinney to close the public hearing. The motion passed unanimously. The public hearing was opened at 9:17 a.m.

Motion by Vick, second by Weber to recommend to the RPA 8 Policy Board approval of the amendments to FFY 2023-2026 RPA 8 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion on Safe Streets and Road for All (SS4A) Plan for cities within RPA 8

Ravada went over a draft scope of service outline with the board members. Ravada stated the consultants, InTrans will be working on crash comparison, data collection, data analysis, formation of MDST groups, development of visions, goals, and objectives, developing improvements and cost estimates. MPO staff will work on public input meetings. Staff will also be setting up meetings with all cities, schools, MDST groups, and other special groups. Ravada stated initially staff were thinking of completing the plan within 14 months. However, Federal highway stated it should take at least 2 years and if plans are submitted before the two-year timeline Federal highway will not look at the plan as they feel the plan is not complete. Ravada stated the outline will be sent out to all members for their input.
